The Criminology and Forensic Science Department of SBRR Mahajana First Grade College has taken permission and arranged for the field visit to the Central Prison of Mysore after due preparations and awareness of conduct.

Details of the department organizing the event in collaboration with institution:

The Department of Criminology & Forensic Science organized the event in collaboration with the Central Prison of Mysuru.

Purpose and scope of the event:

To study various facilities, reformatory measures, training, and rehabilitation processes of prison along with its overview in order to know more about correctional administration.

Details of the event:

We were shown almost everything in the prison after a thorough check-in. Those under trial and pity prisoners were all in prison where few were inside the barrack and others occupied doing tasks like loom, carpentry, salon, cooking in the kitchen, tailoring, and baking.

There were other facilities like the chapel, meditation room, playgroup for sports, and visitor room to talk with family. There day to ensure freshness. There are about 25 staff and 850 inmates currently the prison development board provides funds for prison development activity. The health department takes care of the inmates. There are also images provided here. Money is directly transferred to the account of prisoners based on the Vedas, then we were given more details by the inspector.


She told us about parole escape and how he was captured and for years a lot more study examples over securing our question madam was very friendly as she shared with us about the

Overall, the visit was very enlightening, and was interesting to know the life of inmates and how correction institutes must be maintained.


No. of participants:


