NSS, Dept of Physical education, NCC and Red cross SBRR Mahajana FGC(A), mysuru in collaboration with St.Joseph's Hospital, Bannimantap Mysore organized Blood Donation camp , where 101 NSS volunteers, NCC cadets, students and Teaching staffs donated blood

Rotaract club: Rotaract club of SBRR MFGC(A) was a part of the campaign Anemia free India initiated by the Government of India, first Rtn.Sonia mandappa conducted a session on Anemia and instilled the basic understanding of the concept and dangers of Anemia in girls and women, iron tablets were distributed for free if the HB count was below 10 Project Bhandavya our parent club Rotary Mysore Midtown organized "Bhandavya 2022 sports for the differently abled" more than 10 special schools participated in the event, activities like 50 meters running, relay, shot put and long jump etc.,42 Rotaractors from the club participated and acted as volunteers for the event

MSW: The post graduate department of social work organized Elder abuse awareness program and signature campaign in collaboration with help age India.
