


with confidence and demand for the salary packages, whether you are a fresher or an experienced candidate.

- To enhance students' understanding of research design, data collection, and analysis techniques.
- To provide practical exposure through interactive sessions.
- To cultivate critical thinking and analytical skills among participants.

Day 1: Review of Literature

Date: 26.02.2024

Resource person: Dr. M.V Sunil Librarian, Systems and general management, SDMIMD, Mysuru

The workshop covered a range of topics related to the review of literature. Key areas addressed included:

The Purpose of a Literature Review: The session explored the importance of a literature review in establishing the context of research, identifying research gaps, and informing research questions.

Developing Research Topic: Participants learned strategies for refining broad research interests into focused and manageable topics.

Search Strategies and Resources: The workshop provided guidance on conducting effective searches for relevant academic sources through databases, library resources, and online search engines.

Critical Analysis of Literature: This session focused on techniques for critically evaluating research articles, including assessing methodology, research findings, and limitations.

Organizing Sources and Taking Notes: The resource person discussed strategies for managing large amounts of research data, including reference management software and note-taking techniques.

Writing Literature Review: The workshop concluded with tips for synthesizing and integrating research findings into a wellstructured literature review section for a research paper or thesis.

A detailed discussion and Hands on: The resource person later taught several applications and tools available to aid in searching for literature reviews and academic papers namely Google Scholar, Web of science, Mendely, Zoter and concluded the session.

Day 2 and 4: Social Science package for social sciences

The workshop started with an overview of SPSS, explaining its significance in data analysis and its role in research methodology. Participants were introduced to the SPSS interface, including the data editor, variable view, and output window.

#### 1. Data Import and Management:

- · Participants learnt how to import data into SPSS from various sources and formats.
- They were guided through the process of cleaning and preparing data for analysis, including handling missing values and outliers.

#### 2. Descriptive Statistics:

- The workshop covered basic descriptive statistics in SPSS, such as calculating measures of central tendency and dispersion.

#### People's Participation for Sustainable Development of Cities and Citizens

Department of Social Work, Pooja Bhagwat Memorial Mahajana Postgraduate Center in collaboration with Grassroots Research and Advocavey Movement (GRAAM) Hanss Seidel Foundation (HSF), Participatory Research in Asia (PRIA) had conducted a 'Governance Talk Series' on the subject "People's Participation for Sustainable Development of Cities and Citizens" as part of 'Youth for Governance Fellowship Mysore 2023'.

Only when the youth are physically and mentally strong, they can reach their goals, and only when the attitude of the youth to involve themselves in the political & Governance system increases, a good social status will be achieved, said the Honorable Mayor of Mysuru Mr. Shivakumar, he addressed the youth in the 'Governance Talk Series' programme held at Mahajana PG Centre, Mysuru. While speaking Shivakumar said, Youth should develop the right to speak which is one of the rights in a democratic system. India is composed of more youth and should develop a spirit of participation and questioning only then a better society can be seen. However, the recent youths are not interested in anything, they are not aware of the political system and they are losing interest as well as the participation is declining, he expressed regret.

In the conversation, senior social activist and former president of Mysore Consumer Council, Dr. Bhami V. Shenai said that the participation of Mysore youth in governance is very low. He called upon the youth to be actively involved in the issues of urban governance in the city such as encroachment of parks, conservation of Chamundi hills, revitalization of Kukkarahalli lake, adequate footpaths, garbage disposal etc.

Manjunath HL, Program manager, Civic Partnership of Janaagraha, informed the youth about the local government and explained its importance. He emphasized the importance of the duty and performance of the Mysore City Corporation in providing infrastructure to the urban residents.

National Green Skills Committee (CII-IGB) Chairman Shri K. Shriram said we are currently in an excellent position to find solutions to complement the government's efforts for sustainable development for students. He said that the challenges in the complex machinery of government are huge and youth have every right to criticize.
