Dr. B R Jayakumari welcomed all the hon'ble members of the Academic council to the meeting.

### **Agenda 1**

Ms. Geetha D, presented the proceedings of the previous meeting. The same were ratified.

### **Agenda 2**

Dr. Sreedhara H presented the program structure of all UG programs of II Year Revised CBCS curriculum and said the total no of credits will be 53, wherein a student will earn 26 credits in III semester and 27 in IV semester.

Dr. Guru suggested that as an autonomous institution the college must offer innovative courses which lead to immediate placement.

Dr. C K Renukarya and Sri Parmeshwar Hegde pointed out the practical problems faced like some university nominees do not approve changes in title and total change in syllabus content.

Dr. Guru pointed out that UUCMS portal does allow change in titles of courses and UGC never stipulates that change in content should be only 30%. He also wanted to know the feasibility of recording the objections raised by University nominees in the BoS Proceedings. Nodal officer Sri Parameshwar Hegde pointed out that under the Revised CBCS Curriculum a student will earn 128 credits.

### **Agenda 3**

Presenting the UG syllabi, Dr. Sreedhara said the syllabi was mailed to all the Hon'ble members of A.C. He highlighted that the Departments of Kannada, Hindi and Sanskrit have changed their syllabi completely while retaining titles of courses listed in the university.

## **The house ratified the syllabi of II year (III and IV Semesters) of all UG Programs**

#### **Agenda 4**

PG Syllabi of all the four semesters of nine departments were presented.

Prof. Guru wanted to know why the syllabi of PG programs are revised every year.

Dr. C K Renukarya, said that with the implementation of NEP, the students of PG programs have studied NEP curriculum at UG and therefore there is a need to update the syllabi of all the PG programs.

#### **Agenda 5**

Approval was sought for amendments made to the existing regulations of UG and PG.

Amendment – No. 1, Sl. No. 14 of the regulation. Appointment of BoE Chairperson and Member:

Extension of the tenure of the BoE Chairperson and members from one year to two years for Undergraduate and Postgraduate programs.

#### **The house approved the above amendment**

Amendment - No. 2, (PG Regulation) To promote academic excellence the following change was proposed.

Sl. No. 7 of the regulation, Eligibility to appear for C3, conditional clearance based on Grade=4 has been dropped. A student will be declared as pass provided the student obtains 30% marks in C1 & C2, 30% of the total marks in C3 and 40% in C1, C2 & C3 put together.

#### **The house approved the above amendment**

#### **Agenda 6**

It was brought to the attention of the house that the college is offering Diploma in Hotel Management and Diploma in Aviation and Tourism Management. The Diploma is offered over two semesters with 40 credits (I Semester 18 credits, II Semester 22 credits) and the total marks is 1100.

Prof. C K Renukarya said the diplomas are in high demand with lot of job opportunities. The eligibility for the diploma is SSLC/PUC.

Prof. Guru sought to know if these students would gain lateral entry to UG programs of Tourism. Prof. C K Renukarya said there is no provision for lateral entry and most of the students would find placements.

#### **The house ratified the courses of Diploma in Hotel Management and Diploma in Aviation and Tourism Management**

#### **Agenda 7**

Details of Value-added courses for the academic year 2025-26 offered by UG and PG Departments were presented for approval.

Prof. Naganna appreciated the initiative to offer VAC titled English for Competitive Exams but expressed his anguish regarding delay in appointments for various government posts.

#### **Agenda 8**

Details of certificate course in IKS (Indian Knowledge System) was presented for ratification.

Sri Parameshwar Hegde, Nodal Officer and Convenor of IKS Cell provided details of the course to the house.

- The certificate course is of 30 hrs. with 2 additional credits gained by the student. The exam pattern would be of MCQ pattern.
- The college has signed an MoU with Nucleus of Learning and Development, Gujarat, to guide the college in offering the course and has also agreed for the use of their organisation Logo for certification.
- The course is foundational in nature and has been approved by the Board of Studies in Mathematics.
- Currently the college faculty members are teaching the course in blended mode.
- The course is mandatory for all first year students. In the odd semester it is offered to BBA and B.Sc. students. In the even semester it will be offered to B.Com., BA and BCA students.

### **The house ratified IKS Certificate Course**

Shedding light on IKS Course, Prof. S R Ramesh said that PG Department of Life Sciences had organized a lecture series on IKS like Ayurveda, Homeopathy and Unani. Some relevant components are incorporated in the syllabus of Life Sciences courses.

Principal Dr. B R Jayakumari brought to the attention of the house that an FDP on IKS in collaboration with NLD was organised in which all faculty members of both UG and PG participated.

Dr. Bhaskar H N, Director, Physical Education highlighted that the Men's wrestling team has won the MUICT for the 14<sup>th</sup> year in a row among other achievements. He also expressed that the sports students are happy and satisfied about the support provided by the management and college.

Prof. Guru also sought information on the additional qualifications of the teaching faculty and the performance of students in semester end examination.

The house appreciated the efforts and accomplishments of the students.

Dr. C K Renukarya said that majority of the PG faculty are Ph.D. holders.

The Principal Dr. B R Jayakumari said that most of the UG faculty members also have additional qualifications like Ph.D./M.Phil./ NET/ K-SET.
