- Dr. B R Jayakumari, Principal and Member Secretary of the Governing Body introduced and welcomed all the members to the meeting.

Resolutions:

Agenda I

- Proceedings of the previous meeting held on 11.02.2025 were presented by Smt. Poornima S, and the same were ratified.

Agenda II

- Dr. Sreedhara H, sought ratification of Allocation of grants and Revised Examination Fee for the academic year 2025-26 approved by the Finance Committee. He brought to the attention of the house that the Examination fee is revised to the tune of 10% every year.

Dr. C K Renukarya, brought to the attention of the house that the institution is yet to receive funds from UGC.

Dr. T Vijayalakshmi Muralidhar sought clarification whether the revision is limited to 10% only. In response, Dr. K Mantelingu said that at the University, except affiliation fees and examination fees, all other fee are revised by 10% only every year.

The Governing Body ratified the Finance Committee's recommendation.

Agenda III

- Dr. Sreedhara H presented Agenda III for ratification. He brought to the attention of the Governing Body the fact that the institution has retained the revised CBCS Program Structure of the University. Speaking on the content of the syllabus, he highlighted that the departments while retaining the course titles have changed the contents in the range of 10% – 30% and thus meeting the expectation of improving the syllabus as an autonomous institution.

Dr. C K Renukarya said that the syllabi of the PG programs are revised every year.

Dr. K Mantelingu sought to know if submitting Dissertation is a part of the curriculum as it increases employability opportunities.

Dr. C K Renukarya said that the Dissertation/Projects is a part of all the PG programs except Chemistry. Dr. S R Ramesh mentioned that as approved by respective Boards of Studies, the M. Sc. students of Biotechnology, Biochemistry and Microbiology have to undertake the projects during their IV semester and they have to submit Dissertation based on their Project work.

Dr. Roopa, HoD of the Dept. of Chemistry pointed out that the university nominee insisted on following the university pattern of not having Dissertations. Dr. Mantelingu stressed the need for having Dissertation/Projects in the interest of the students as it gives them necessary exposure to meet industry requirements. He suggested that the Chemistry department should explore the feasibility of offering the theory papers in the first three semesters and the Dissertation work in the IV semester. Adding to the discussion, Dr. Pratima emphasized the need for skill-oriented programs to ensure better job opportunities for the students.

Regarding the Institution of Diploma in Hotel Management and Diploma in Aviation & Tourism Management, Dr. Sreedhara said:

The Diploma is offered over two semesters with 40 credits (I Semester 18 credits, II Semester 22 credits) and the marks in total would be 1100.

Dr. Prathima sought details on eligibility criteria and the infrastructure for practicals for the Diploma courses.

In response, Prof. C K Renukarya said the diplomas are in high demand with lot of job opportunities. The eligibility criteria for the candidates is pass in SSLC/PUC. As the institution is already offering BBA in Hotel & Hospitality and BBA in Aviation and International Tourism, it has a full-fledged kitchen to provide the necessary skill training. He also said Mahajana Education Society awards the Diploma. Dr. Mantelingu appreciated the initiative.

Dr. Pratima suggested offering PG Diploma in Tourism exclusively for BA students to enhance their job opportunities. Dr. C K Renukarya said the institution will soon send a proposal to the UoM.

- Dr. Sreedhara invited Sri Parameshwara Hegde, Convener for presenting the details of IKS certificate course.

Sri Parameshwara Hegde said the IKS course is offered in collaboration with Nucleus of Learning and Development, Gujarat. The duration of the course is 30hrs and the syllabus is introductory in nature. The course is offered to first year students of all programs. The faculty members of the college themselves are teaching the course. An online exam is conducted for 50 marks and the student earns two additional credits, in the process.

Sri B S Ravi Kumar sought to know if grants are available for offering value-added courses.

In response, Dr. C K Renukarya, said grants are not available. Therefore, relevant concepts of IKS are incorporated into the syllabus. He highlighted that the School of Life Sciences has organized Lecture Series on Ayurveda, Homeopathy and UNANI System of medicine by inviting practicing doctors to promote ancient knowledge among students.

Offering additional details, Dr. S R Ramesh said relevant components from IKS are introduced in the syllabus of M.Sc., Biotechnology, Biochemistry and Microbiology programs.

Dr. Mantelingu suggested to explore the introduction of Western Ghats' plants as a topic in the syllabus.

- Regarding the BoE, Smt. Shruthy Poonacha said instead of one year, the term of BoE has been increased to two years from the academic year 2025.

Sri B S Ravi Kumar wanted to know if the members of the previous term are continued for the subsequent term and if Guest Faculty are listed as BoE members ?

The Controller of Examinations said that BoE members shall be continued for another term unless black listed for erratic valuation. Under exceptional cases, in concurrence with the Principal, Guest Faculty can be a part of the BoE work.

- Dr. Sumathi M P provided details on the revised Mathematics syllabus for B.Sc. 1st year. The revised syllabus contains only 3 units in comparison with the earlier syllabus which had 4 units.

The CDC Director wanted to know if there is a separate Mathematics syllabus for BCA. Dr. Sumathi said, a separate syllabus focusing on Discrete Mathematics and Graph Theory is framed for BCA program.

- The minutes of IQAC meeting held on 19.08.2025 were presented for ratification before the Governing Body. Ms. Geetha briefed the house about the activities conducted during the academic year 2024-25.

Dr. C K Renukarya during the discussion about activities conducted for Competitive exams, said that the institution is exploring the possibility of offering a Bachelor's degree in Competitive Exams. Sri Ravi Kumar said in addition to having quality faculty members to teach the subjects, it is essential to have professionals on the board to offer guidance on strategic preparation for the exams.

With regard to offering new subject combinations, Dr. Ramesh briefed the house that he has already discussed with Smt. Shruthy Poonacha to constitute a Joint Board of Studies involving the BoS members of the departments of Life Sciences, Computer Science and Mathematics to frame the syllabus for the new combinations to be offered in UG from the year 2026-27.

Dr. Sreedhara tabled the agenda regarding Revision of Project/Dissertation Remuneration from Rs. 120/- to Rs. 500/- on par with the University of Mysore.
